BA American Studies Kernfach

For modules in your major American Studies, please enroll via **TOOL** between March 25, 9 am, and April 5, midnight. For parallel courses, choose early to get the seat you want. Once your registration procedure is finalized you are automatically enrolled for the respective module exam.

For your minor (Wahlbereich), browse the university's course listings and use the TOOL to select four modules for the Wahlbereich and three for the "Schlüsselqualifikationsmodule" (SQM) for which you want to apply. The order of your list automatically serves as your priority list. You need to do this between March 25, 9 am, and April 1, 5pm. Starting April 2, 1pm, you will need to confirm your selection of modules.

BA American Studies Wahlbereich and Wahlfach

If you study American Studies as your Wahlfach or Wahlbereich, you may select from the following modules:

- **Society, History, and Politics I** – SHP I (04-001-1002);
- **Introduction to Linguistics for American Studies** – LS I (04-001-1003);
- **Literature and Culture II** – LC II (04-001-1007);
- **The Anglo-American World in a Global Context** – AAWGC (04-001-1008);
- **Society, History, and Politics III** – SHP III (04-001-1010);
- **Literature and Culture III** – LC III (04-001-1011); and
- **Language and Society – Language in Transition** – LS III (04-001-1012).

Please note that all of our modules require English language skills at level B2 Common European Framework (i.e., at least 6 years of language instruction). **LC II, AAWGC, SHP III, LC III, and LS III** also require completion of related introductory modules.

Select your modules via TOOL between March 25 and April 1. Starting April 2, 1pm, you will need to confirm your registration for Wahlbereich and also select your parallel slots there (for modules offered in parallel slots).

We will offer remaining seats through the Restplatzbörse beginning April 7.

MA American Studies

Please choose your modules via TOOL between March 25, 9 am, and April 1, 5 pm. Second-semester MA students may select from the following four modules:

- **Political Cultures in a Transatlantic Context (04-038-2005)**
- **Media and Society in a Transatlantic Context (04-038-2006)**
- **Difference and Literature (04-038-2007)**
- **Inter-American Spaces and Latino/a Cultures (04-038-2008)**

Fourth-semester MA students will write their MA theses.

Magister students may attend MA modules, but need to check back with the instructor.

Information for Individual BA Kernfach Cohorts

First-Year BA Students (Entering Class of 2014):

Second-semester BA students will attend the compulsory modules **Society, History, and Politics I (04-001-1002, SHP I)** and **Introduction to Linguistics for American Studies (04-001-1003, LS I)**. You are guaranteed a place in these modules, but for the Society, History, and Politics I seminar and tutorial you may have to compete for a seat in the parallel slot of your preference. Seating in the parallel slots is limited and handed out on a first-come, first-served basis via TOOL.

Second-Year BA Students (Entering Class of 2013):

Fourth-semester BA students may attend **Literature and Culture II (04-001-1007, LC II)** and/or **The Anglo-American World in a Global Context (04-001-1008, AAWGC)**.

In the 2014/15 academic year, ASL offers a total of four modules for second-year BA students, of which you need to use three for your Kernfach. In addition you may also choose to take some of these four modules as Wahlbereich. In that case, please enroll via the TOOL's Wahlbereich section.

Third-Year BA students (Entering Class of 2012):

Sixth-semester BA students may choose one, two, or all of the following modules: **Society, History, and Politics III (04-001-1010, SHP III)**; **Literature and Culture III (04-001-1011, LC III)**; and/or **Language and Society – Language in Transition (04-001-1012, LS III)**.

For enrollment in the modules, you are asked to sign up via TOOL between **March 25, 9 am, and April 5, midnight**.
