### ***BA American Studies: Overview***

Please enroll via TOOL between October 4 (noon) and October 10 (5 pm) and consult the guidelines:

For modules in your **major** American Studies: For parallel courses, choose early to get the seat you want. Once your registration procedure is finalized, you are automatically enrolled for the respective module exam! You might switch or cancel individual slots until TOOL closes, though.

For your **minor** ("Wahlbereich"): Browse the university's course listings and use the TOOL to select your modules for the Wahlbereich and for the "Schlüsselqualifikationsmodule" (Professional Skills Modules / SQM) for which you want to apply. The order of your list automatically serves as your priority list.

**Starting October 11, you will need to confirm your selection of Wahlbereich modules and select your parallel slot (if it applies) online.**

Below you will find more information on your individual study cohort:

### **BA Kernfach Cohorts**

#### **First-Year BA Students (Entering Class of 2018)**

In your first semester, you will attend the **compulsory** modules "Literature and Culture I" (LC I) and iTASK. You are guaranteed a seat in both modules, but for the LC I seminar and tutorial you may have to compete for a seat in the parallel slot of your preference. Seats in the parallel slots are **limited** and handed out on a first-come, first-served basis via TOOL. Please do double-check your the schedule for your minor(s) in order to avoid overlaps or conflicts!

#### **Second-Year BA Students (Entering Class of 2017)**

Third-semester BA students may attend "Society, History, and Politics II" (SHP II), "Language and Society – Applied Linguistics" (LS II), and/or "Ethnicity and Diversity in US Culture" (ED). Parallel slots are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. If you choose to take one of these modules **as Wahlbereich**, please enroll via the TOOL's Wahlbereich section.

#### **Third-Year BA Students (Entering Class of 2016)**

Fifth-semester BA students attend the Project Module (PM) as a compulsory module.

You are guaranteed a place in this module, i.e., a seat in one of the three parallel colloquia offered. Each colloquium can only admit a limited number of students, thus, seats are handed out on a first-come, first-served basis via TOOL.  
The final admission lists are pending approval by the respective instructor!

### **MA American Studies**

Please choose your modules **via TOOL between October 4, noon, and October 10, 5 pm.**

Entering students will need to sign up for the three compulsory modules: “Methods and Theories” (M&T); “Graduate Colloquium” (GradColl); “iCAN.”

Students in the entering class of 2017 may select from the following modules: “Consumption, Culture, Identity” (CCI); “Immigration, Ethnicity, Citizenship” (IEC); “Transatlantic Space” (TS).

### **BA American Studies as Wahlbereich**

If you study American Studies as your minor, you may select from the following modules: “Literature and Culture I” (LC I); “Society, History, and Politics II” (SHP II); “Language and Society – Applied Linguistics” (LS II); “Ethnicity and Diversity in US Culture” (ED).

Please note that all of our modules require English language skills at level B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference (i.e., at least 6 years of language instruction - “Grundkurs”). SHP II, LS II, and ED also require the completion of related introductory modules.

We will offer remaining seats through the Restplatzbörse as of Monday, October 15.

### **Lehramt Englisch**

Students who take the module “American Literatures, American Societies” (04-AME-2401) may select one of the three lectures and one of the four seminars offered. Please pay attention to the enrollment information offered by your home institution:
